As we reflect on our 60th Anniversary year, I am deeply grateful for all the Lord has done. This milestone has been a time of celebration and reflection, with a renewed commitment to our mission of providing a sacred space for spiritual renewal.

Our celebrations began with a Matt Maher concert and Eucharistic procession, followed by events like Masses with Bishop Conley, an Ablaze worship night, our inaugural Celebration Dinner, and a Christ at the Center Christmas celebration. These gatherings helped us give thanks for six decades of blessings.

At the heart of our ministry are the thousands of retreatants who come seeking silence, prayer, and a deeper relationship with God. Many have shared how their time here has been transformative. One retreatant said, "The renewal, rest, reflection, and time with our Lord is unmatched." Another shared, "The silent retreat gave me ways to improve my relationship with God, and I plan to share this with my family."

This year, over 2,500 retreatants visited us, an increase of 350 from last year. We expanded our offerings of Ignatian retreats, spiritual healing, and youth programs, with over 500 students experiencing the value of a retreat. We now join the Church in a "Year of Prayer" for the 2025 Jubilee Year, inviting you to join us in deepening your prayer life and placing God at the center.

Your generosity has helped us maintain and improve our facilities, making retreats more accessible. Special thanks for your support during the Nebraska Catholic Day of Giving. As we continue our mission, we rely on God's providence and your prayers, participation, and financial support. Your involvement is vital to helping others experience the transformative power of retreat.

In closing, one retreatant's words resonate deeply: "We all need to get away from the noise and reconnect with Jesus. The Good Counsel Retreat House is that place." Thank you for being part of our 60-year journey. I pray that Our Lady of Good Counsel will continue to guide us as we look forward to many more years of spiritual renewal.

FROM GARDEN ROOTS...

The "Back to the Garden" retreat was a weekend retreat filled with peace, hope, and love for so many. It attracted women from various backgrounds, all seeking a deeper connection to their faith. Many of the attendees agreed that this weekend was a life-changing experience, and one that drew them closer to the Holy Spirit.

Sarina Stokes, a key speaker and creator of the retreat, explained the deeper spiritual meaning behind the theme: **"Your heart is the garden, it's the indwelling of God.** This is what you've been made for, but there's a place of woundedness in the feminine heart that really ruptures our relationship with Jesus."

Sarina's words highlighted the universal theme of healing and spiritual renewal, especially for women who have experienced hurt, loss, or alienation in their personal faith journeys.

Sarina also noted, "**This retreat is about allowing women to encounter Jesus' mercy in that place of hurt, like Mary Magdalene did in the garden after the Resurrection**. Jesus wants to come into and redeem even the darkest nights in one's story through His own story. His wounds become a place of intimacy."

The retreat sold out quickly and is a testament to people's desire for a spiritual and sacred experience. An attendee shared, "This retreat was one of the most powerful and beautiful retreats I have ever been on. I have never felt God so closely. I loved the little details they included to make the experience very real and to help you feel the beauty of your feminine heart. Every woman should attend and receive that kind of love from the Heavenly Father."

This retreat is an example of another new form of outreach and invitation that the Retreat House is facilitating on behalf of our Lord. Thank you for your ongoing commitment and support in helping us enrich spiritual lives.
